LAVACA -- Ezell's Fish Camp, on the Tombigbee River in Lavaca, has been named the "Best Place To Eat in Alabama" by "Thrillist.Com," a popular online rating service. It recently featured the "One Must Eat Food" in each of the 50 states, stating the best restaurant to find it.

Established in 1937, Ezell's has been in the Ezell family, located in the same pre-Civil War log structure on the banks of the Tombigbee River for almost 80 years. Not surprisingly, Thrillist suggested the famous hushpuppies and cole slaw to go along with their U.S. grown catfish.

Evolving into a destination restaurant, Ezell's Fish Camp attracts visitors from Birmingham, Mobile, Montgomery, and Mississippi throughout the year. Finding a table during the hunting season can sometimes be a challenge, when you might feel out of place without your camouflage gear on.
